Ebenezer Scrooge, an elderly miser, loathes Christmas. When his loyal clerk, Bob Cratchit, has the temerity to ask for Christmas Day off, he begrudgingly accepts.

That night, Scrooge is visited by the chained ghost of his former business partner, Jacob Marley. Tormented in the afterlife for all of the misery he inflicted upon others in his former life, Jacob warns Scrooge that unless he changes his ways, he too shall suffer the same wretched fate.

Scrooge is visited by three spirits, who show him Christmases past, present, and future. Throughout his experiences with the ghosts, he begins to learn the true meaning of Christmas. Scrooge is particularly touched by Cratchit's seriously ill child, Tiny Tim, who he is warned will surely die unless the course of events changes.

Scrooge awakens on Christmas Day morning a changed man. He sends a large turkey to the Cratchit home for Christmas dinner, gives Cratchit an increase in pay, and becomes a father figure to Tim. From then on, Scrooge treats everyone with kindness, generosity, and compassion, embodying the spirit of Christmas.
